## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Pre-fit all fenders BEFORE you paint them.
- 2. Fenders can be trimmed/cut with a cutoff tool or dremel.
- 3. Check clearance on lowered rear suspensions with the rear fully collapsed.
- 4. Check front fender for corner clearance, forward control clearance, tool bag clearance.
- 5. Check rear caliper for clearance (rear caliper can be relocated on some models).
- 6. Check tire clearance.
- 7. Are you frenching-in lights or license? Check the clearance.
- 8. Drill any holes you need for seat mounting, pillion brackets, luggage mounting, light mounting, fender trim, rear racks, license mounting, etc. prior to painting.
- 9. Sand gel coat with 320 grit and prime.
- 10. Finish sand primer with 400 wet/dry paper and apply base coat.
